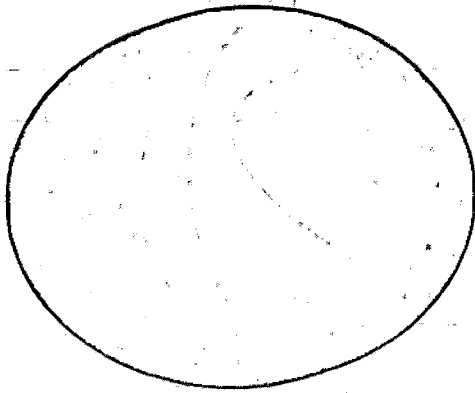

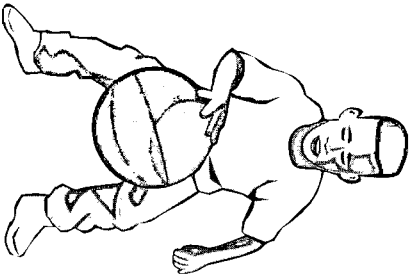

demonstrations

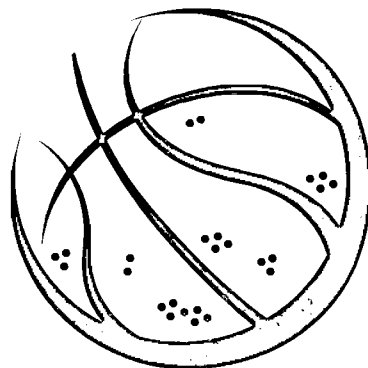
**9:30-10:15** Fundamental station drills.
